All requirements, with the exception of my board of review, were completed prior to my 18th birthday.*

In preparation for your board of review, prepare and attach to your Eagle Scout Rank Application a statement of your ambitions and life purpose and a listing of positions held in your religious institution, school, camp, community, or other organizations, during which you demonstrated leadership skills. Include honors and awards received during this service.

Write about 1 to 2 page statement per the prompt above. As a young adult, use this as an opportunity to consider your long term plans & where you see yourself in 5, 10, 25, 50 years. Who do **you** want to be?

Typical kinds of questions to consider when thinking about what to write:

- What other organizations have you been involved with? How have you demonstrated leadership?
- Are there academic honors or special awards you have received?
- What do you plan to do?
- Will you remain active in the troop as an Eagle Scout?
- What long term /short term goals do you have for your life?
- What do you want to accomplish?
- What is important to you?
- How do you think the ideals of scouting will impact your life?
- Do you plan to be involved in scouting as an adult?
- What have you learned? What do you want to teach others?
- How might you serve your community, nation or planet as an adult?
- Is there a cause you want to support?

Note: Don't be afraid to share this with your parents – it's likely they are keenly interested to know what you are thinking!
