t's time for the mandatory SHAKEDOWN campout! Your Leaders have been working hard to plan a great weekend for you to come together with your troop and learn more about what to expect at the Jamboree. This edition of the Jamboree Journal will be focused on the campout May 5-7 at Ingersoll Scout Reservation.

A few reminders—

- 1. You should come to the shakedown just as if you're leaving for the Jamboree. We realize that you might not have everything prepared yet, or you may have more shopping to do, but do your best to pack as close as you can to the real deal. Water bottles and mess kits are a MUST!
- 2. Tenting arrangements have already been made by your SPL. You will learn your tentmate at checkin.
- 3. The tent you will be assigned is the same tent you will be using at Jambo. Treat it with care, you'll be sleeping in it in July.
- 4. If you are late or need to leave early from Shakedown you should check in/out with one of YOUR adult unit leaders. We understand there are going to be late arrivals, please check in when you arrive.

Do you have Special Dietary Needs? Food Allergies? **Critical Medical Issues? Take Medications?**

Please notify your Patrol Leader or Senior Patrol Leader AS SOON AS POSSIBLE about special dietary need or food allergies. Failure to notify the PL or SPL may result in us not being able to meet your dietary / medical needs for the shakedown campout.

- Scouts that have Epipens[©] or inhalers should plan on bringing TWO of these to the Jamboree. A spare can be provided to your ASM to keep with other medications.
- Medications should be provided when you check in at shakedown and when you leave for Jamboree. All medications should be in a plastic bag with the Scouts name and unit on it. Each medication needs to be in the original container (i.e., prescription bottle/box) with the scouts name. Detailed instructions should be in the bag as to dosage and time of day to be administered.
- Only provide the amount of medication needed for the campout or for Jamboree (10 days, plus a few extra dosage if needed). In other words, don't send a 90 day supply with your scout.
- Medical forms (Parts A&B and insurance cards minimal, C if you have it ready) should be turned in at check-in for Shakedown (required). All parts (A/B/C/cards will be required at check-in before we leave Jamboree and inspected. Scouts with incomplete forms or missing forms WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BOARD THE BUS.
- Wear Medical ID Bracelet at all times if you have allergies or a medical condition.

Shakedown Campout Timeline Friday 5/5



- Eat Dinner before you arrive!
- 4:45–5:30 PM Arrive @ ISR Family Camping/Shooting Sports Parking lot When you enter the gates at ISR, go STRAIGHT ahead—the parking lot is on the left before the hill right by the radio tower. PARKING WILL BE TIGHT. Scouts should be dropped off with their gear as quickly as possible so others can do the same. Late arrivals check in and you will be directed where to go.
- Check in at Family Camping Pavilion
 - Turn in Medical Forms (COPIES of Parts A, B and C if you have it, along with Insurance cards and Medications—keep your originals!) to your Asst. Scoutmaster upon arrival— notify your ASM of Medications, Allergies or Critical Medical Issues. Medications should be in original containers, with instructions all in a ziplock bag labeled with Scouts Name and Jamboree Troop Number(use Boy/Girl/Crew for now.)
- 5:30 PM—Troops depart for camp location to set up camp

Saturday 5/6

A full day of training sessions, team building games and challenges, hikes, and more!

Sunday 5/7

- 6:30 AM— Wake Up! Breakfast and Campsite Teardown
- 10:00 AM—Scouts Own Service
- 10:30 AM Parent Q&A (Rifle Pavilion)
- 11:30 AM—Departure
