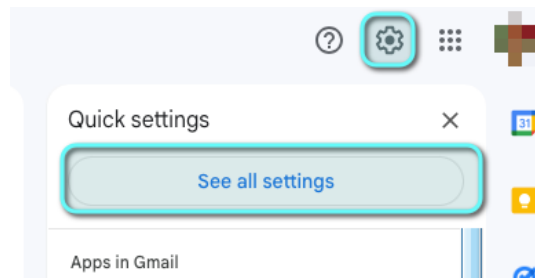


How Do I “Whitelist” @Scouting.org Emails in Gmail?

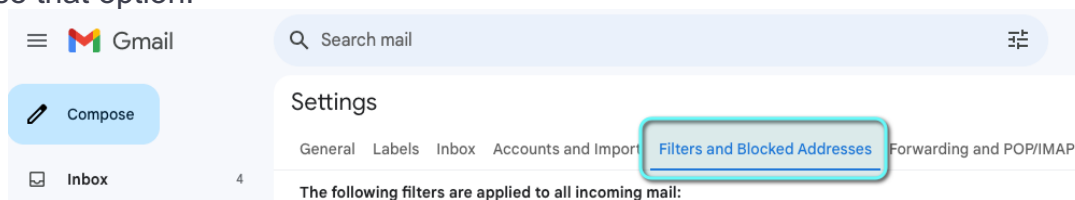
Don't use Gmail? Visit <https://blog.hubspot.com/marketing/email-whitelist>, check your email service/client's Help section for instructions on “spam filter” and “whitelist” creation, or simply use the instructions below as a general guide.

Step 1. Log into your Gmail account.

Step 2. Locate and click the **gear icon** ⚙️ in the top right-hand corner of the Gmail interface – that's the **Settings** button. Then click the **See all settings** button.

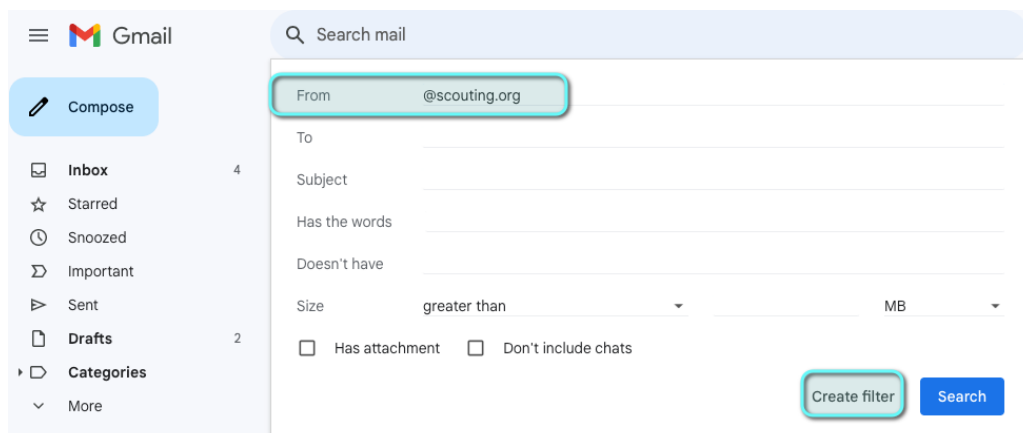


Step 3. Locate the section in the top ribbon called **Filters and blocked addresses** and choose that option.

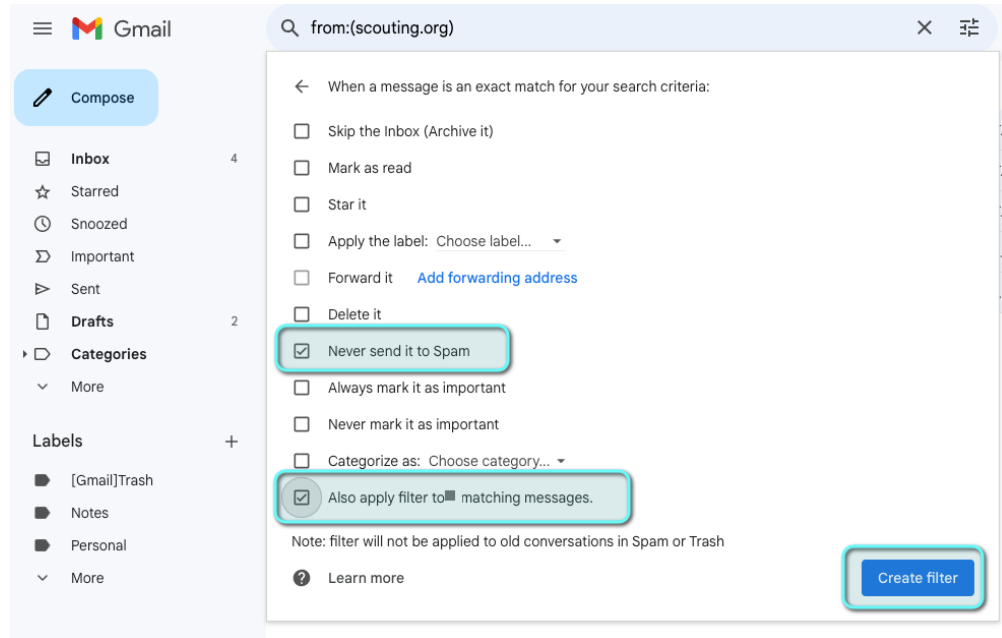


Step 4. Choose **Create a new filter**.

Step 5. Find the **From** option and then simply type in “@scouting.org” then click **Create filter**.



Step 6. Now choose **Never send it to spam**. And to ensure Gmail applies this setting to all the emails you have previously received, you need to choose **Also apply to matching “X” messages**. *Finally, click **Create filter**.*



Now repeat Steps 1-6 for “@wdboyce.org”

Step 7. That’s it – done!!
