Duties of the Position:

- Lead programs as a mentor to youth in grades K -5th, many from at-risk neighborhoods in the Peoria, at local schools or community centers.
- Plan and conduct fun, weekly programs.
- Track attendance and achievements/advancements for each youth at weekly meetings and submit data weekly.
- Planning outdoor activities with assigned supervisor.
- Build relationships with local organizations to further Scouting programs in the community.

Position Requirements:

- Ability to interact enthusiastically and effectively with youth and adults.
- Showcase excellent interpersonal skills and be willing to learn new skills.
- Excellent <u>punctuality</u> and <u>accountability</u> (24-hour notice of absence).
- Scouting background is not necessary, although helpful.
- Personal transportation is required.
- Light lifting, physical activity (running and jumping) in youth activity settings required.
- Applicants must be 21 years or older and be able to successfully pass a criminal background check.

Work Days and Hours:

- School-year: programs run for 1 hour after school with 15 minutes before and after for prep and clean-up. Multiple sites may be required each day.
- Supplies will be provided for programs through the Scout office
- A mandatory meeting will be scheduled once every month for all program specialists and leaders to coordinate the following month's calendar and distribute supplies
- Average hours per week: 5-10; each site is an hour and a half long. Currently have 2 sites, working on adding more.

Compensation:

- Compensation starting \$16/hr
- Compensation applies for required trainings
